


WCPS DIVISION INFORMATION

Dual Instruction

COVID-19 cases have skyrocketed in Alberta. While Alberta teachers are taking every precaution available to them to make classrooms safe for themselves and their students, some families are choosing not to send their children to in-person classes, even if they are not under quarantine orders. This can create a very challenging teaching environment, and many teachers are left wondering if they should be expected to plan both online and in-person lessons for those students who quarantine or whose parents refuse to send them to school.

Teachers cannot be expected to separately plan lessons for, instruct or assess both students in the classroom and those who choose to obtain their learning exclusively at home. In situations where students are unable to return to school, the schools will need to work with parents to find alternative delivery methods for these students. Direct instruction augmented by student completion of tasks outside classroom attendance can be accommodated. Just like students who miss school for illness and vacation, teachers should be prepared to send home curricular activities or assignments arising from direct instruction as much as they would in those instances. Teachers need to plan for in-school instruction. An expectation to plan fully for both in-person and online instruction would be an unacceptable increase in expectations and workload for teachers.

TOWN (URBAN) BUS STUDENTS

Students living in Lacombe

MUST re-register for busing each spring for the fall



User Pay fees are applied to students who live less than 2.4 km from school.

User Pay students are accepted on a first come first served basis

AND only if there is space available on a bus.

User Pay students will be put on a waiting list if their registrations are

received late and/or the bus in that area is full.

If you have moved you must notify the school of the address change PRIOR to registering for busing.

Cross Boundary students must re-apply each year by filling out the regular application and the cross boundary application.

Please note that cross boundary fees will apply.

Fees are currently under review and will be released by the School Board in late spring 2021.

(Distances are calculated using a routing software and Alberta Education criteria)

COUNTRY (RURAL) BUS STUDENTS

Lacombe students who live in the country and are new to

please call us with your legal land description.

Whole School Fitness: Look How Far We've Run!




